On June 02, 2017, the Texas Supreme Court decided to decline to hear the case, thus unfortunately, the decision of the Texas Court of Appeals dismissing our case was affirmed.


In essence, the decision of the Courts was that even assuming that we had factually proven that the majority of Saddam Hussein's mustard gas in existence at the time of the 1991 Gulf War came from the chemical (TDG) that was supplied by the Defendant, Alcolac International, we could not prove that the exact mustard gas molecules that contaminated the plaintiff in 1991 might not have come from TDG supplied by another company.

Since the case was under Texas State tort law, this effectively ends the litigation of 24 years (1993-2017). It was a crusade that was worth pursuing. The case was publicized and the fact of the ordeal of the litigation itself should serve as some deterrent to other companies in the future from selling the means for chemical weapons and other weapons of mass destruction to rogue and enemy regimes.
